BURNING BYLAW REGULATIONS



BURNING PILED WOOD, BRUSH

You can burn **dry piled, non-painted, non-treated** wood, brush, leaves or wood by-products **only**, (***no kitchen garbage, materials made of/ or containing rubber, plastic, tar, polystyrene or any material prohibited by the Environmental Protection Act and any regulations there to***) without a fire permit, provided you meet all of the following conditions:

- The fire is only allowed if the Burk's Falls & District Fire Department and/or the Ministry of Natural Resources have not declared a **TOTAL FIRE BAN**. (Check with your Municipal Office)
- **NO DAYTIME BURNING From April 1<sup>st</sup>. to October 31<sup>st</sup>** a fire is only allowed to burn from between the hours of **6.00pm. in the evening to 10.00am in the morning.**
- Only a **single pile** is burned **at any one time.** The pile is not more than two meters (6 ft) **in diameter** and less than two meters (6 ft) **high.**
- The fire is at least **15meters (55 ft) from any dwelling or structure, 3meters (18ft) from any flammable or combustible materials.** (Bush Brush etc.)
- **You have adequate tools(shovels, racks, brooms) and water to contain the fire, to the fire site.**
- A **responsible person** tends the fire until **it is extinguished.**
- The **property owner** is still **liable** if the fire is not contained.
