BURNING BYLAW REGULATIONS



BURNING GRASS

*You can burn areas of grass or leaf litter on land you lawfully occupy or give permission to burn grass and leaf litter on land you lawfully occupy, without a fire permit, provided you meet all of the following conditions:*

- The fire is only allowed if the Burk's Falls & District Fire Department and/or the Ministry of Natural Resources have not declared a TOTAL FIRE BAN. (Check with your Municipal Office)
- From November 1<sup>st</sup> and until March 31<sup>st</sup> **burning may be permitted in the daytime.**
- NO DAY TIME BURNING From April 1<sup>st</sup>. to October 31<sup>st</sup> a fire is only allowed to burn from between the hours of 6.00pm. in the evening to 10.00am in the morning.
- The total area to be burned does not exceed one hectare. (2.5 Acres)
- The flaming edge of the fire does not exceed 30 meters (100ft) in length.
- A responsible person tends the fire until it is extinguished.
- You have adequate tools and water to contain the fire to the fire site.
- The property owner is still liable if the fire is not contained.
