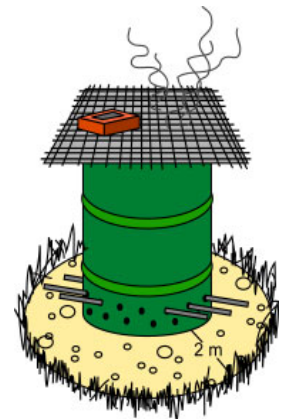

BURNING BYLAW REGULATIONS



INCINERATOR BURNING

You can burn wood, brush, leaves or wood by-products only, (no kitchen garbage, or any material prohibited by the Environmental Protection Act) in an incinerator, without a fire permit, provided you meet all of the following conditions:

- The fire is only allowed if the Burk's Falls & District Fire Department and/or the Ministry of Natural Resources have not declared a TOTAL FIRE BAN. (Check with your Municipal Office)
- From November 1st and until March 31st burning may be permitted in the daytime.
- NO DAY TIME BURNING From April 1st. to October 31st a fire is only allowed to burn from between the hours of 6.00pm in the evening to 10.00am in the morning.
- The incinerator is an enclosed device constructed entirely of non-combustible material.
- A screen having a mesh size of not more than five millimeters (1/4") covers the incinerator.
- The incinerator is at least six meters (20ft) from any forest or woodland.
- The incinerator is at least six meters (20ft) from any flammable or combustible material.
- A responsible person monitors the fire until it is extinguished.
- The property owner is still liable if the fire is not contained.
