

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ARMOUR

BY-LAW #13-2016

Being a by-law to regulate the disposal of refuse or debris within the Township of Armour and repeal By-laws #21-89 and #28-2008

WHEREAS Section 127 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, Chapter M.25, as amended, permits municipalities to pass by-laws prohibiting the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality; and

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Amour deems it desirable to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris in any place in the Township other than the Armour, Ryerson, Burk’s Falls landfill site.

Be it enacted as a By-law of the Corporation of the Township of Armour as follows:

1. In this by-law, refuse and debris shall have the meanings normally attributed to them and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall include:
 - 1.1 The portions and containers of food unused or discarded in the preparation, serving and consuming thereof.
 - 1.2 All discarded materials arising or resulting from the operation of a household, business establishment and public places; and
 - 1.3 Brush, stones, surplus concrete or asphalt, broken concrete or asphalt, tires, appliances, furniture, clothing, material from construction or demolition projects, vehicles or equipment.
2. General Duties and Obligations to Comply
 - 2.1 No person shall spill, scatter, deposit, throw, cast, lay or cause to be thrown any refuse or debris on any street, lane, alley, laneway, roadway, road allowance, public or private way or in any public square, place or private lot.
 - 2.2 Materials applied to land for agricultural purposes are exempt from the provisions of this by-law.
3. General Provisions
 - 3.1 The By-law Enforcement Officer appointed by the Township of Armour shall enforce this by-law.
 - 3.2 Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a set fine (Schedule A) or penalty of \$5,000 (five thousand dollars) for each offence exclusive of the costs, as prescribed by the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33, as amended.
 - 3.3 This by-law shall repeal the former Township of Armour by-laws #21-89 and 28-2008.
4. Short Title
 - 4.1 This by-law may be referred to as the “Dumping By-law”.
