

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ARMOUR

By-Law #60-2018

Being a by-law to appoint an Integrity Commissioner

WHEREAS Section 223.3 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, as amended, authorizes municipalities to appoint an Integrity Commissioner who is responsible for acting in an independent manner to apply the Code of Conduct of Council and local boards and other such duties as may be assigned to them by the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Magnetawan issued a Request for Proposal on behalf of twelve (12) Almaguin Municipalities seeking the services of an Integrity Commissioner and received proposals from:

- Weaver, Simmons LLP
- Elston Watt, Barristers & Solicitors
- ADR Chambers Inc.
- Robert J. Swayze, Barrister & Solicitor
- Cunningham, Swan, Carty, Little & Bonham LLP

AND WHEREAS the twelve (12) Almaguin Municipal Clerks appointed an Evaluation Committee to evaluate the proposals; with the proposal from Elston Watt, Barrister & Solicitor receiving the highest combined score based on the evaluation criteria as detailed in the Request for Proposal;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Municipal Corporation of the Township of Armour enacts as follows:

1. That the Request for Proposal for an Integrity Commissioner be awarded to Elston Watt, Barristers & Solicitors.
2. That Elston Watt, Barristers & Solicitors is hereby appointed the Integrity Commissioner for the Township of Armour.
3. That this By-law, Request for Proposal and the successful proposal from Elston Watt, Barristers & Solicitors shall form an agreement to purchase services between the Township of Armour and Elston Watt, Barrister & Solicitor.
4. That this By-law shall come into force and effect upon its passing.
