



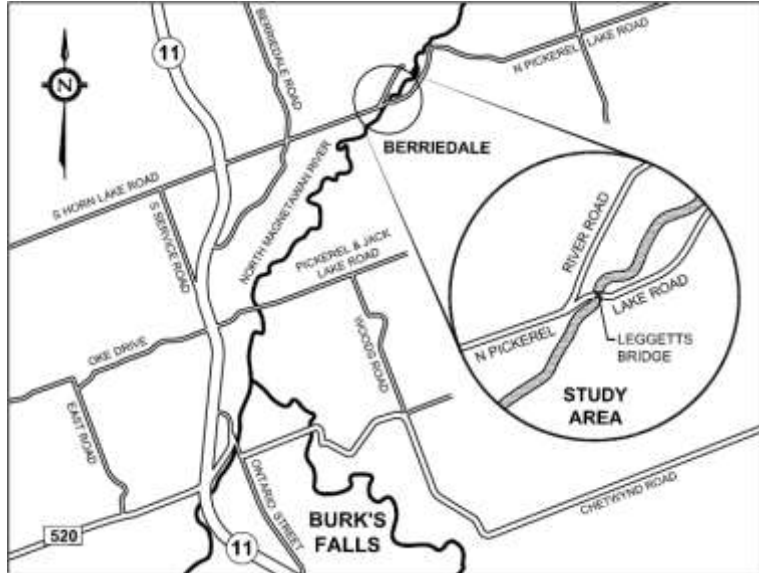
Leggetts Bridge Improvements Township of Armour Schedule 'B' Class Environmental Assessment

NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

The Township of Armour (the Township) has completed its undertaking of a Schedule 'B' Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to provide professional engineering design and construction administration services for the improvements to Leggetts Bridge in the Township of Armour (see **Key Map** below). Leggetts Bridge is located on North Pickerel Lake Road and carries roadway traffic over the North Magnetawan River. The purpose of the improvements is to provide the safe management of vehicular traffic after construction and provide adequate access to the area for local residences, emergency services and tourists to the area. This study is being funded in accordance with the requirements set out in the Build Canada Fund Intake 1 agreement.

Key Map – Study Area

This study is being conducted in accordance with the requirements for a Schedule B Class EA project as prescribed in the Municipal Engineers Association's *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document (October 2000, as amended in 2007). The Class EA process includes public and review agency consultation, evaluation of alternatives, assessment of the potential effects on the environment, and identification of reasonable measures to mitigate any adverse effects. An Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been



prepared to document the planning and decision-making process. By this Notice, the ESR is being placed on public record for a 30-day review period, in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class EA process. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and the necessary approvals, the Township of Armour intends to proceed with the detailed design and construction phase as documented in the ESR.

The Environmental Study Report will be available starting on **December 1, 2009** for public review for 30 calendar days at the Township of Armour Clerk's office and the Burk's Falls Public Library.

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If concerns arise during the prescribed review period that cannot be resolved through discussion with the Township of Armour, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act. This would then subject the project to an individual environmental assessment. This request (commonly referred to as a Part II Order) must be received within the above prescribed 30 calendar day review period by the Minister, at the address listed below and copied to Ms. Wendy Whitwell at the Township of Armour. If no request is received on or before **Thursday, December 31, 2009**, the Township may proceed with detail design and construction of the project.
