

TRI R COMMITTEE PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES

June 3, 2009

The public meeting for the purpose of explaining an application for a further two year capacity increase at the existing landfill site, was held on Wednesday, June 3rd, 2009 at the Armour Township office and called to order at 7:15 p.m..

The Chair opened the meeting by explaining the purpose for the second emergency expansion, and invited questions. Guests in attendance inquired about the method of notification. The circulation process was explained.

Jason Balsdon discussed communication with the MOE to date, and their role in obtaining approval for the expansion project. He then described the proposed filtration ponds and how they would work. Those in attendance inquired further about the filtration process. Jason explained that the "constructed wetland" cannot be built without MOE approval, which has not yet been obtained. He also used visual aids to identify monitoring sites, and the locate the current and proposed waste footprints.

The process of creating the correct slope using recently acquired compaction equipment was discussed. The 2009 Monitoring program was also briefly discussed.

Jason indicated that written comments could be submitted within the next few weeks, and questions and comments can be directed to the Landfill Administrator.

The Chair thanked guests for their interest and attendance. Jason was also thanked for his presentation and information.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:58 p.m.
