A TRI-Council meeting of the Council of the Township of Armour, Council of the Township of Ryerson and the Village of Burk's Falls was held on Monday, April 30, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the Burk's Falls Senior Centre, 136 Yonge Street, Burk's Falls and hosted by the Township of Armour.

The meeting was called to order by Reeve Bob MacPhail at 7:00 p.m.

NOTES FROM TRI-COUNCIL MEETING:

The meeting notes from the TRI-Council meeting held on January 29, 2018 were accepted as circulated and approved by resolution.

REPORTS AND FINANCIAL UPDATES:

Waste Management

TRI-Council reviewed the Waste Management Administrator's report and financial update. TRI-Council discussed the new system for the cards at the gate. We will be extending the use of the present system until the end of 2018. TRI-Council also discussed how the purchase of the garbage truck is progressing. The Administrator is still looking for an appropriate garbage truck.

Fire Department

TRI-Council reviewed the Fire Chief's report and financial update. A Fire Prevention Officer has been hired and will have to take the appropriate courses to be certified.

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April 30, 2018

Economic Development

TRI-Council reviewed the Economic Development Officer's report and financial update. The Economic Development Officer presented his report and explained what he has changed in what his report covers. Questions were asked and answered.

Arena

TRI-Council reviewed the Arena Manager's report and financial update. TRI-Council was advised that Burk's Falls has received funds for a Recreation Coordinator and for equipment. They presently have an advertisement out to hire a Recreation Coordinator on a two-year contract. They are also looking at purchasing equipment which would save energy and reduce costs. A discussion ensued on the fact that the fees at the arena should be adjusted to come closer to cover the cost of the arena.

Library

TRI-Council reviewed the March 2018 CEO report and the 2018 library budget. TRI-Council asked about the contribution from McMurrich/Monteith. They have made a presentation to McMurrich/Monteith's Council, but they have not received a response yet. They have not given them a date as to when they need to respond.

MAHC - Hospitals

A verbal report was given on the status of negotiations and municipal responses on how our hospitals will be replaced or renovated. TRI-Council discussed a recommendation brought forward to represent ourselves so we are not left on the outside of the negotiations. Each Council will need to discuss this issue and see what can be accomplished in the next six months. The municipalities that would represent themselves would be North of Novar to North of South River. Most of the residents in this area use the Huntsville Hospital, but Huntsville is in a different Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) than Almaguin; therefore, the Huntsville Hospital does not receive money to fund the care of Almaguin area patients. Almaguin is considered to be in the North East Local Health Integration Network (LHIN). A letter will be sent to the surrounding municipalities to determine if they are interested in joining together and if they are willing to represent themselves as a separate LHIN.

OLD BUSINESS:

TRI-Council discussed the cost of drafting the shared agreement and the response we received from the lawyer doing the work. TRI-Council agreed to pay the invoices.


