COVID-19 UPDATE

In order to continue to provide waste management services at the TRI R Landfill & Recycling Centre during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Townships of Armour and Ryerson have adapted the processes at the site as a progressive step to ensure the health and safety of site staff and our residents.

It is essential for everyone to understand the role of these frontline workers during this drastic time and continue to practice the physical distancing just like you would at the grocery store, gas station or hospital, with the staff and other residents while on site. Please also limit your trips to the site. Sorting blue boxes at home will reduce your duration of time and exposure at the site.

- All steel & aluminum containers, glass jars & bottles & all numbered plastic containers and film packaging are placed together in the big blue compaction machine, outside the Quonset hut.
- Cardboard and boxboard should be broken down and packed together inside the Quonset hut.
- Mixed paper, including newspapers, flyers, and advertisements should be packed together inside the Quonset hut. Shredded paper must be left in the bag it was brought in.
- **DO NOT RECYCLE USED KLEENEX AND PAPER TOWEL.**

We realize being stuck at home may be difficult and that some have started on the spring cleaning and yard work, please be aware of the fees that apply for disposal, staff do not have the authority to waive the fees.

WE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTING DONATIONS FOR THE REUSE OR DIABETES CANADA UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

WE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTING CASH AS PAYMENT FOR FEES, PLEASE BE PREPARED TO USE A DEBIT CARD.

It is essential for anyone who may be under quarantine, or those providing care, to bag all waste that has come into contact with the ill. This includes, Kleenex, paper towel, water & juices bottles, or any packaging that would normally be recycled. Dispose of this bag at the landfill disposal area. Under no circumstance should items from a quarantined household be brought for recycling or diversion.
